

LATTICE MARKET BAG CROCHET PATTERN



The **Lattice Market Bag Crochet Pattern** looks intricate, but it's much easier than it looks! For this bag, I used Lily's Sugar 'n Cream cotton yarn. Because crocheted market bags have a tendency to stretch, I wanted to use a strong cotton. This yarn does the job!

Materials

3 skeins Lily Sugar 'n Cream in Overcast (any worsted weight cotton)

4.5 mm hook

yarn needle

scissors

Level

intermediate

Pattern notes & Stitches to Know

magic circle

ch - chain

dc - double crochet

sc - single crochet

- Written in US terms
- ch 3 counts as dc
- ch 1 does not count as sc
- The pattern is made as one entire piece starting at the bottom with joined rounds

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make a magic circle

Round 1: ch 3, 11 dc in circle, pull circle closed tight, join to first ch 3 with sl st (12 dc)

Round 2: ch 3, dc in same stitch, 2 dc in each stitch around, join to first ch 3 with sl st (24 dc)

Round 3: ch 3, 2 dc in next, *dc, 2 dc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first ch 3 with sl st (36 dc)

Round 4: ch 3, dc in next, 2 dc in next, *dc in 2 stitches, 2 dc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first ch 3 with sl st (48 dc)

Round 5: ch 3, dc in next 2, 2 dc in next, *dc in 3 stitches, 2 dc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first ch 3 with sl st (60 dc)

Round 6: ch 3, dc in next 3, 2 dc in next, *dc in 4 stitches, 2 dc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first ch 3 with sl st (72 dc)

Round 7: ch 3, dc in next 4, 2 dc in next, *dc in 5 stitches, 2 dc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first ch 3 with sl st (84 dc)

Round 8: ch 3, dc in next 5, 2 dc in next, *dc in 6 stitches, 2 dc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first dc with sl st (96 dc)

Round 9: ch 3, dc in next 6, 2 dc in next, *dc in 7 stitches, 2 dc in next* repeat from * to * around, join to first dc with sl st (108 dc)

Round 10: ch 3, 2 dc in same stitch, ch 2, skip 3 stitches, sc in next, ch 5, skip 3 stitches, sc in next, ch 2, *skip 3 stitches, 5 dc in next, ch 2, skip 3 stitches, sc in next, ch 5, skip 3 stitches, sc in next, ch 2* repeat from * to * around, to last 3 stitches, skip 2 stitches, 2 dc in last, join to first ch 3 with sl st

Round 11: ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), dc in next, ch 1, dc in next, ch 2, sc in ch 5 space, ch 2, *(dc in next dc, ch 1) four times, dc in next, ch 2, sc in ch 5 space, ch 2* repeat from * to * around, to last 2 stitches, (dc in next dc, ch 1) twice, join to first ch 3 with sl st

Round 12: ch 5 (counts as dc + ch 2), dc in next, ch 2, dc in next, *(dc in next dc, ch 2) four times, dc in next* repeat from * to * around to last 2 dc, (dc in next dc, ch 2) twice, join to first ch 3 with sl st

Round 13: ch 3, 2 dc in ch 2 space, dc in dc, 2 dc in ch 2 space, dc between next 2 dc, *(2 dc in next ch 2 space, dc in dc) three times, 2 dc in next ch 2 space, dc in between next 2 dc* repeat from * to * around, to last 2 dc, 2 dc in ch 2 space, dc in dc, 2 dc in ch 2 space, join to first ch 3 with sl st

Round 14 - 25: repeat rounds 10 - 13 three more times

Round 26 - 27: ch 3, dc in each stitch around, join to first ch 3 with sl st (108 dc)

STRAP

Row 1: ch 1, sc in 8 stitches (8 sc)

Row 2 - 61: ch 1, turn, sc in each stitch across (8 sc)

Fasten off. Leave a long end for sewing.

Sew the last row of the strap to the opposite side of the bag from where the strap started (46 stitches from row 1 of the strap).

Sew with a whip stitch using the long end.

Weave in all the ends.
